Honour one another above yourselves"</i> 1 Peter 3 V 8 <i>"Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble"</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To understand the differences are what make us unique and special. To recognise the suffering of others and seek to do something about it.
Year 5	Justice and Peace Amos 5 v 24 <i>But let justice roll on like a river, righteousness like a never-failing stream!</i> Colossians 3 v15 <i>"Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful"</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To ensure to be fair in all we do. To stand up against injustice when it appears.
Year 6	Humility and courage Philippians 2 v 3 <i>"Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather, in humility value others above yourselves"</i> 1 Corinthians 16 v 13 <i>"Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong."</i>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> To have the courage to follow the right path even when others don't. To recognise that each individual is unique and no one person is more important than another. To be the change you want to see.
