

## **SATS results in 2014**

### **READING**

100% of children achieved at least level 4

43% of children achieved level 5

100% of pupils made at least 2 levels of progress

43% of pupils made more than expected progress.

### **WRITING**

71% of children achieved at least level 4

29% pupils achieved level 5

86% of children made at least 2 levels progress

14% pupils made more than expected progress.

### **MATHS**

86% of children achieved at least level 4

29% of children achieved at least level 5

14% of children achieved level 6

86% of children made at least 2 levels progress

43% of children made above expected progress.

Due to the small cohorts it would be immoral to analyse this data more deeply in such a public forum however parents must assured that governors and school leaders dig much deeper and are implementing plans to ensure any barriers to learning for specific groups of children are pulled down through careful planning, interventions and good teaching.
