## **Geography Vocabulary List**

This list is a guide and should not put a ceiling on learning for those who want to know more, nor should it be a barrier, particularly for children with processing difficulties. At the start of each Key-stage (end for UKS2) the list from the previous year can be explored with children sorting words into those they know, those they have heard but can't explain and those they have never heard. This will give teachers a good starting point and discussion to familiarise themselves with their new classes and their Geography understanding.

**EYFS-** directions, naming features they see, visit to Rowan head to develop understanding of different localities but also the concept of land meeting sea. Children can talk about where they love and how they get to important places. They will talk about their holidays.
